

YOUTH OUTREACH COORDINATOR

Job Description

The Youth Outreach Coordinator at Wingfoot Church is responsible for developing and leading a program to connect neighborhood youth to Christ-centered mentoring relationships. This position is partially funded by a federal ARPA grant.

Job Requirements

- A vital and growing relationship with Jesus.
- A sensitivity to the leading and conviction of the Holy Spirit.
- A willingness to participate in the life and community of Wingfoot Church.
- A self-starter who is able to develop relationships with students and volunteers from diverse socioeconomic backgrounds.
- Ability and willingness to communicate and collaborate with ministry partners.

Job Responsibilities

14 Hours / Week

Wingfoot Church (4 hours / week)

- Personal Development (1 hour / week)
 - Meet weekly with the staff supervisor for leadership development and personal discipleship.
- Ministry Internship (3 hours / week)
 - Contribute to the ministries of Wingfoot Church on a weekly basis on Sunday mornings.

Youth Violence Prevention Program Coordinator (12 hours / week)

- Relational Development (4 hrs / week)
 - Identify and engage opportunities to develop connections and relationships with students in the outreach target area.
 - Recruit, organize, and train adult mentors.
- Program Leadership (4 hrs / week)
 - Select and implement an age-appropriate mentoring curriculum.
 - Lead bi-weekly after school program in coordination with volunteers and program partners.
 - Coordinate program schedule with building program partners and volunteers.
- Administration (4 hrs / week)
 - Provide monthly reporting on progress toward target metrics and expenses for the purpose of grant reporting and accountability.
 - Attend bi-monthly grant recipient meetings.
